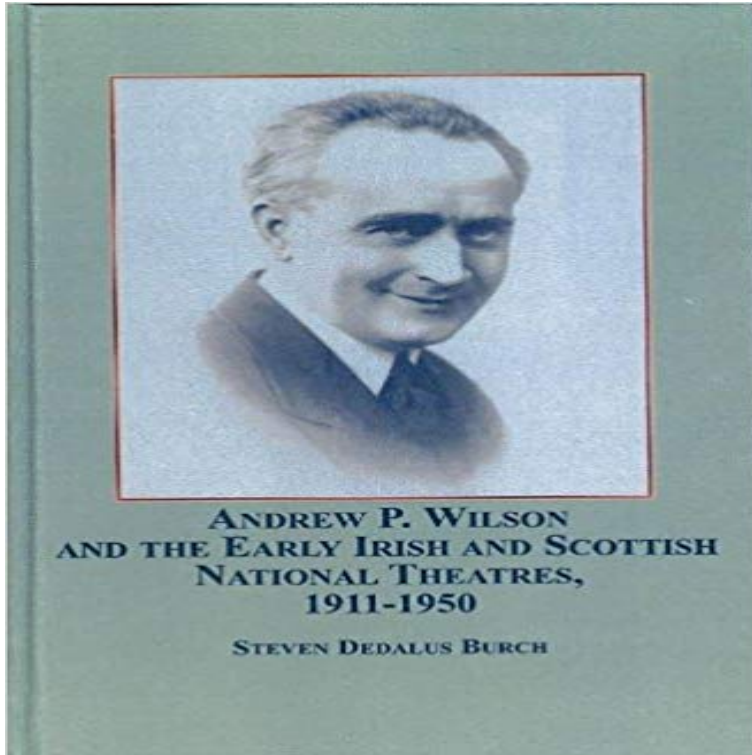


Andrew P. Wilson and the Early Irish and Scottish National Theatres, 1911-1950
