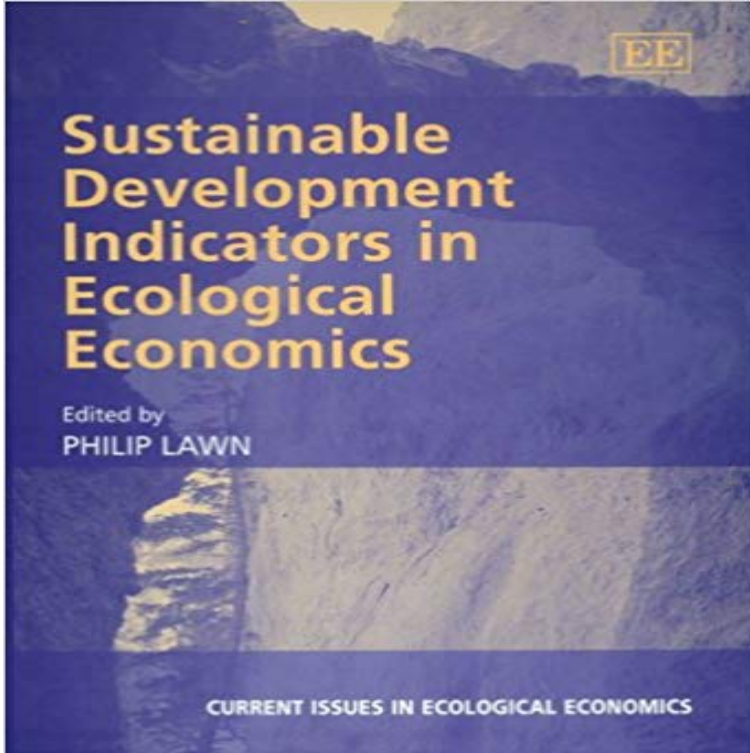


Sustainable Development Indicators in Ecological Economics (Current Issues in Ecological Economics Series)
