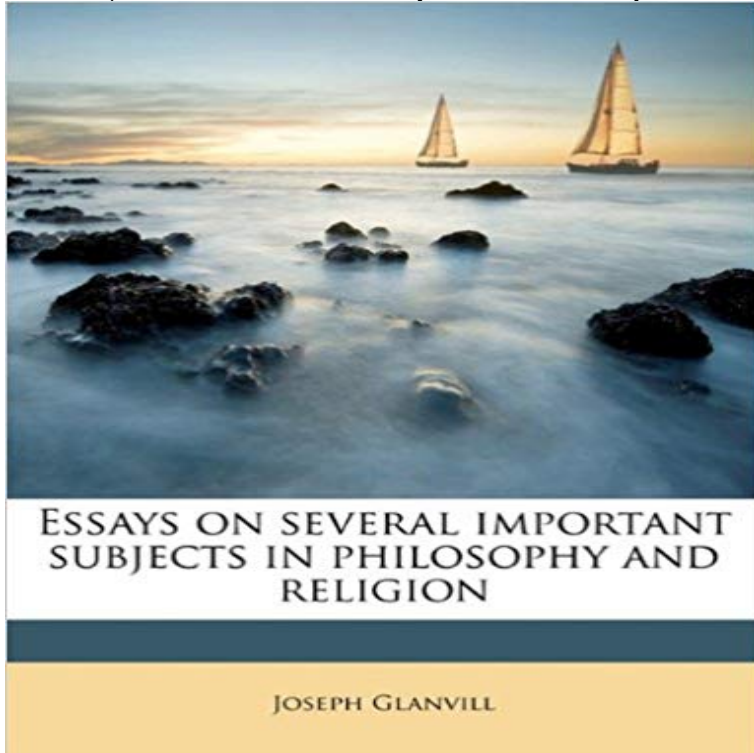


## Essays on several important subjects in philosophy and religion
