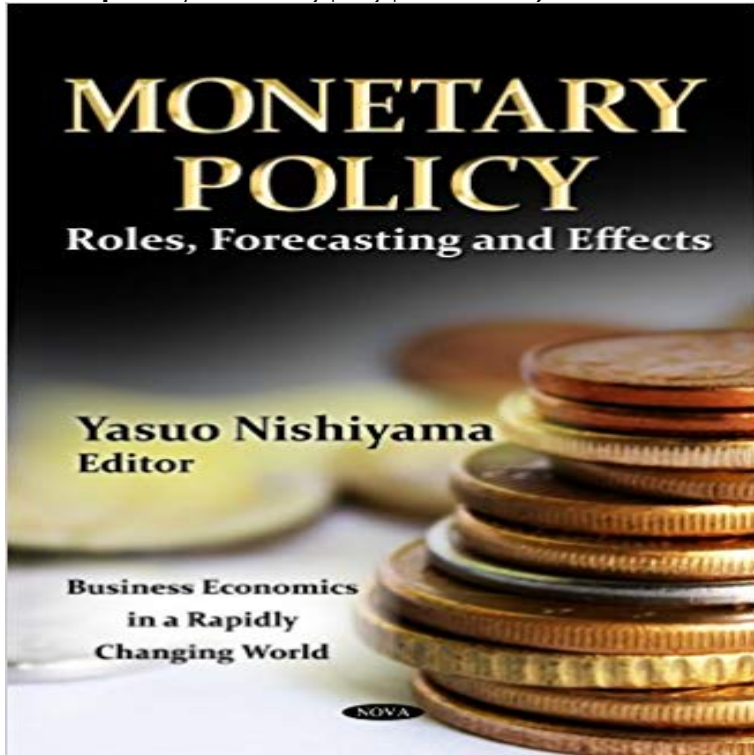


## Monetary Policy: Roles, Forecasting and Effects (Business Economics in a Rapidly Changing World)
