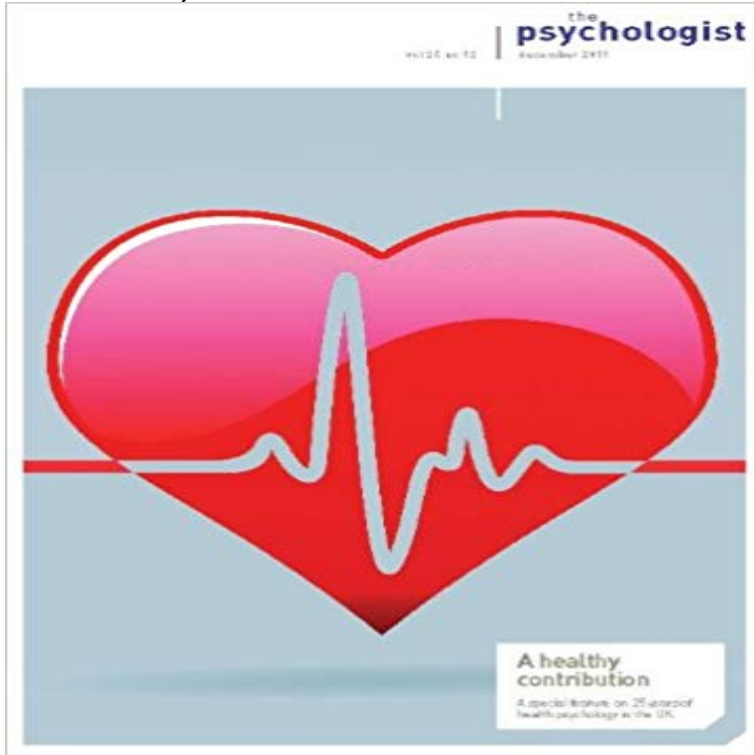


The Psychologist magazine December 2011 (The Psychologist 2011 Book 12)
