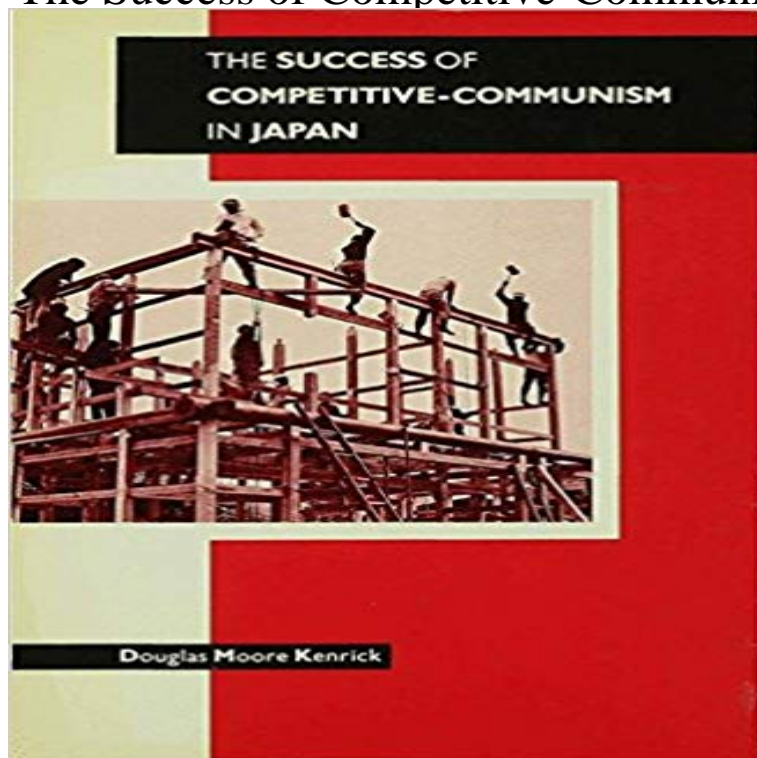


The Success of Competitive-Communism in Japan
